# 2018 New Zealand 29er National Championships

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## Notice of Race

NB. The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

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### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply
- 1.3 The 29er One Design Class Rules will apply
- 1.4 Appendix T will apply

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### 2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 Applies. [DP]

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### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the 29er class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the form in B and scanning/emailing to [info@boiyachtclub.co.nz](mailto:info@boiyachtclub.co.nz) by Sunday May 27, 2018
- 3.3 Late entries will be accepted up to 1000 Saturday 2nd June 2018, note the higher fee.
- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each helm and crew member must be a financial member of a club recognised by the helm and crew member's national authority.
- 3.5 Proof of a club membership must be presented at Registration.
- 3.6 Each helm and crew must be a financial member of the New Zealand 29er Association or a 29er Association affiliated to the International 29er Association.

- 5.7 On Monday 4<sup>th</sup> June no warning signal will be made after 1600

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## **6. Measurement**

- 6.1 Each boat shall be presented to the Regatta measurer ( Clause 5.2 above)
- 6.2 All boats must comply with their class rules at all times during the Regatta. No equipment that is subject to measurement under 29er class rules may be changed during the Regatta without the approval of the Chairman of the Race Committee
- 6.3 Wet clothing, measurement and equipment checks may be made throughout the Regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee or Protest Committee.

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## **7. Sailing Instructions**

- 7.1 The sailing instructions will be available at Registration and will be posted on the Bay of Islands Yacht Club website when available.

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## **8. Venue**

- 8.1 The Regatta will be based at Bay of Islands Yacht Club
  
- 8.2 Racing will take place on the waters off Waitangi, Bay of Islands. See Attachment A

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## **9 The Courses**

- 9.1 The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward

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## **10 Penalty System**

- 10.1 For the 29er class rule 44.1, Taking A Penalty, is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty

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## **11. Scoring**

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- 11.1 Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series
- 11.2 a) Until five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.  
b) When from five to eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.  
c) When nine or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores

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## **12 Support Boats**

- 12.1 The movements of support boats will be restricted. [DP]

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## **13 Launching Restrictions**

- 13.1 Unless otherwise directed by the organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from Bay of Islands Yacht Club. [DP]

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## **14. Radio Communication**

- 14.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not voice or data make transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

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## **15 Prizes**

- 15.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in the Regatta. There may be other prizes awarded by the Organising Authority.

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## **16 Disclaimer of Liability**

- 16.1 Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the Regatta.

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## **17 Insurance**

- 17.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with the valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
